1960 - 1963 Employed as an Articled Survey Pupil with Alan Wood & Company, North Sydney, NSW. Experience included urban and rural subdivisions, Strata title subdivisions, Identification Surveys, control and set-out of highrise, and factory buildings, detail surveys involving tacheometric and plane table techniques together with general engineering and hydrographic surveys.

1963 - 1969 Employed as an Instrument Man / Party Leader with McKay & Richards, Kempsey, NSW.
